

2020: Does the IMechE have a clear vision?

The current three year plan for the (IMechE) is being developed by the Trustee Board for approval in December. It will cover the date in January 2022 of the 175th anniversary of the Institution's formation in 1847. Over those 175 years it is clear that many more organisations have come into existence that are also capable of delivering the IMechE's original core purpose "To give an impulse to invention likely to be useful to the world".

The IMechE's present day mission statement is "Improving the world through engineering", but what should the IMechE aim for in the future?

This talk will cover the unique features and strengths of the IMechE that are argued still give it a relevance in the 21st Century. By definition however that positioning cannot be the same as the one that stood our forebears in good stead. The world has moved on and the Institution needs to as well. The skill of the Trustees and the input of the wider membership in being a part of that evolution will be explored.
