Ir. Albert Yeu – Founding Chairperson of Hong Kong Institute of Construction Adjudicators

Albert is a chartered civil engineer and chartered project management surveyor with extensive experience in design and construction of tunnel, bridge, highway, waterworks and flood prevention scheme in Hong Kong. Projects involved the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, urban trunk sewerage system, major flood prevention projects, strategic new town development infrastructure projects, urban drainage improvement works, consultancy procurement and tendering on a variety of construction contracts. He is experienced with remeasurement type, works order type, lump sum with BoQ, design&build and NEC contracts. He is an accredited NEC3 ECC Project Manager, a member of the Institution of Civil Engineers (UK) and Hong Kong Institution of Engineers.

Albert is a construction arbitrator, construction adjudicator and accredited mediator. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and is the current Chairperson of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (East Asia Branch) Young Members Group, a mediation coach at the Hong Kong Mediation and Arbitration Centre, a council member of the Society of Construction Law Hong Kong and a regular speaker in the areas of ADR and construction contracts. He has numerous publications on the different security of payment legislations implemented around the world, and is also a co-author of the book “Lukas Klee, International Construction Contract Law (2 nd Edition), Wiley Blackwell, 2018”. He is the first Asian appointed in the New Zealand Building Disputes Tribunal panel of arbitrators, mediators and dispute board members.



Ir Gordon Kwok is a Chartered Civil Engineer, Arbitrator, Adjudicator, Contract Advisor, and Accredited NEC3 Project Manager. Working as a civil engineer, Gordon has extensive design, construction and project management experience in numerous mega and community engineering projects including railways, tunnel works, buildings and waterworks.
