“Going driverless: How, What, When ...?”

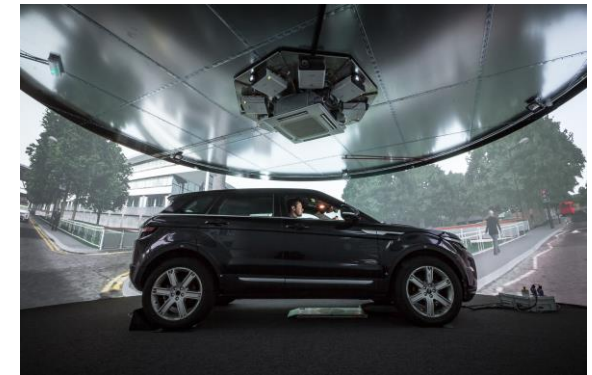

Siddhartha Khastgir is at Warwick Manufacturing Group. His PhD topic is Driverless Vehicles, and he has lectured about this on three continents. His work has concentrated on testing the vehicles, especially in safety analysis and identification of test scenarios.

He is the UK representative on an ISO committee for standards on intelligent transportation systems, and the lead author on a new international standard on low-speed, self-driving, pod-type vehicles. The talk will focus on the potential benefits of driverless cars, and a possible route for their introduction. It will highlight the challenges for industry and the research community, and some ways they may be tackled.
